## Non-Public Session Minutes April 19, 2018 – First Session

<u>Motion</u>: On a motion by Mr. Mitchell and seconded by Mr. Gauthier, the Board voted unanimously to enter into nonpublic session under the authority of RSA 91-A:3, II (c) and (I).

Specific Statutory Reason for Nonpublic Session: RSA 91-A3;II (I) Consideration of legal advice provided by legal counsel, either in writing or orally, to one or more members of the public body, even where legal counsel is not present.

RSA 91-A3:II (c) Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting...

<u>Description of Matters Discussed</u>: RSA 91-A3:II (I): Attorney Volinsky advised the Board regarding the *Claremont* lawsuit legal actions, reasons for education funding inequities in the state, and potential legal actions to address this issue. The Board asked several questions on this issue; Attorney Volinsky made several suggestions and agreed to conduct a workshop in Pittsfield on school funding for the Pittsfield community as well as made a reference to another attorney who may be helpful. The Board directed Dr. Freeman to make arrangements for Attorney Volinsky's workshop and to contact the referenced attorney.

RSA 91-A3:II (c): The Board considered two requests for non-resident attendance presented by parents of two PMHS students; requests were made for the remainder of

the school year only and without transportation services; requests were made due to families moving out of Pittsfield after lengthy residence in Pittsfield.

The Board was advised of misbehavior of a student to whom approval for non-resident attendance had been previously granted, including vandalism at Drake Field.

<u>Actions</u>: (1) On a motion by Ms. Douglas and seconded by Ms. Asdot, the Board voted unanimously to approve non-resident attendance to Mackenzie Dumond for the remainder of the school year only without transportation services.

- (2) On a motion by Mr. Gauthier and seconded by Mr. Mitchell, the Board voted unanimously to approve non-resident attendance to Joshua Whittier for the remainder of the school year only without transportation services.
- (3) On a motion by Ms. Douglas and seconded by Mr. Gauthier, the Board voted unanimously to rescind non-resident attendance to Madison Lawlor immediately in the event of inappropriate behavior on Madison's part.
